LIBRARY NEWS

We are excited to announce that Delphos Public Library is a LSTA Competitive Grant award winner! This grant from the federal Institute of Museum and Library Services, awarded by the State Library of Ohio will be used to develop a makerspace in the original portion of the main library. Local funds to complete this project were awarded by the Arnold C. Dienstberger Foundation. Create Space will feature 3D printers, sewing machines, simple robotics, and more. Based on our timeline, this space should be ready sometime in May of 2026! We'll keep the community updated as we make headway on this project.

Update on our <u>American Library Association</u> LTC: Accessible Small and Rural Communities Grant work. Today we added our <u>KultureCity</u> signage, sent our photos in for social story creation, and have our new Sensory Inclusive Bags available for patron use! There are signs to let those with sensory sensitivities know what areas may be loud, where to find sensory bags, and at the doors to let everyone know they are welcome here. We have also purchased:

- * noise cancellation ceiling installations
- * a sensory tunnel
- * Sensory Friendly manipulatives

All of which will make our Early Literacy Play Area more inviting to ALL.

Our next steps are to:


- *complete the play area refresh
- *purchase and install light covers to finish dimming the lights
- *install the tunnel and noise cancellation pieces
- *purchase new furniture for both the main library and storytime areas to make it more friendly to those who need alternative seating
- *provide assistive listening devices for programming etc.

We have even more to come, but these things take time. Please follow us for updates as we make the library more welcoming and accessible for every patron.

Once you reach the 10-hour mark, you will be eligible to enter our exciting prize drawing. Prizes our on display in our curio cabinet.




Join us for Storytime starting in February! We offer the following storytimes:
